THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH

Call me a little bit weird (or a lot weird), but I've been reading through Leviticus in my Bible reading plan and I love it! Leviticus is full of lots of rules for the Israelites. Rules for what to do when fungus or mold shows up on fabric. Rules like you should not kill. I feel like that is an important one. Rules for what a burnt offering is and how to offer it. Rules about what to do when you have a weird rash. Now you might be thinking that I like Leviticus because it has lots of rules. While I like a good rule, especially those that help keep people safe, I am not a fan of rules just to have rules. So, it can be a little overwhelming to read Leviticus, which is essentially a big book of rules. So, why do I love it so much? I love how Leviticus shows us God's character. The rules about burnt offerings remind us of how important a relationship with God is and how it is not something to be done lightly or without thought. The rules about not killing or how to make restitution if someone is accidentally killed by someone else remind us that every human is an image bearer of God and therefore has great value and should not be killed. Even the rules about what to do about fungi, mold, and rashes reveal God's providence in protecting the Israelites. They did not have the science to understand how mold spreads or how infections pass from one person to another and yet God protected them even still. God is so good to guide the Israelites in every aspect of their lives. I love how every part of Scripture points to a Creator that deserves all glory and honor and I am thankful that He included even Leviticus in His Word so that we can see aspects of His character even as He shares rules for living.
